In the Counseling Process Document dtd. 24.05.2024 and Notification dtd. 18.06.2024, COMEDK had notified the eligibility criteria for architecture courses. Subsequently, we are in receipt of the Council of Architecture's Gazette Notification dtd. 06.07.2024 and communication dtd. 08.07.2024 (copy enclosed) prescribing the revised eligibility criteria for admission to 1st year of 5-year B. Arch degree course which is as under:

"No candidate shall be admitted to architecture course unless she/he has passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with either Chemistry or Biology or Technical Vocational subject or Computer Science or Information Technology or Informatics Practices or Engineering Graphics or Business Studies with at least 45% marks in aggregate or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 45% marks in aggregate."

To this extent, the eligibility criteria notified for B. Arch courses in COMEDK's Counseling Process Document dtd 24.05.2024 and Notification dtd. 18.06.2024 stands modified.

It is also informed that all the concerned admission authorities in the Country to follow the above eligibility criteria for admission into 1st year of 5-year B. Arch degree course from the academic session 2024-25 onwards.

In view of the above, one more opportunity has been provided to the candidates interested in participating in COMEDK's Architecture Counseling to register themselves. The schedule is as follows:
